



“Art Club 2016 Fall Semester”

It is now time for students in “**5th through 8th grade**” to consider joining the “**Art Club**” for the Fall Semester. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. Classes are held in the Art Room #209 every Monday right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes are conducted during normal “open” school days through the semester.

The cost is \$ 225.00 per semester Sept., Oct., Nov., (total of 11 classes). The first class is Monday Sept. 12th – last class is Dec. 5th. On Dec 5th I will host our semester end “Pizza Party” while student’s finish any remaining projects. All payments must be made out to **Ronda Stieber** (not SJPII) and are due in *full with registration form to Mrs. Stieber* to secure a spot. All Students are *encouraged* to bring a drink and snack. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class will begin promptly after set-up. Students will be walked down to car pool at 5:00 P.M. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 will be responsible for fees as per the Parent/Student Handbook. Middle school student’s whom are trying out for teams may see me regarding.

The Planned Fall Art projects are:

1) Acrylic/Gesso 2-Dimensional Abstract Painting - A variety of multi-media including; fabric/yarn/papers will be applied to the surface area of the framed 24” X 36” canvas to create 2-D shapes/forms then painted with Gesso to set. Student’s will then freely paint with a colorful variety of acrylic paints in solids and metallic to detail their painting using different tools to create interesting design elements.

2) Marti Gras Plaster face/mask – Students will create a male or female mask with layered plaster using a face form. Once dry student’s will add hair and facial details to the surface then paint with a variety of acrylic paints. Beads, jewels, sequins and paint will be added to personalize and embellish.

3) Holiday Craft Ornament Project - Difficulty will be on an individual basis depending upon the time students take to complete the above two projects. Students will create a plaster Mache’ shape as desired, then paint with colorful acrylic paints in both solid and metallic then can add jewels, sequins, glitter to create patterns and detail.

...Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive behaviors are required!
