



Art Club 2017 Spring Semester

It is now time for students in **5th through 8th grade** to consider joining the **Art Club** for the *Spring Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging, creative art projects. We meet in the Art Room #209 on Mondays right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes are conducted during normal “open” school days through the semester.

The cost is \$ 225.00 per semester: February, March, April-(includes May class), a total of 11 classes- the first class is Monday, Feb. 6th – last class is May 8th. All payments must be made out to **Ronda Stieber, (not StJPII)** and are due in full with the registration form to secure a spot. I will host a Pizza Party on the last club day!

All Students are *encouraged to bring Water and Snack* and should report to the Art Room after school. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class begins promptly at 3:30 after middle school dismissal.

Students will be walked down to carpool promptly at 5:00 P.M. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 will be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up your child from the art room as needed.

The Planned Spring projects are:

1) Square Basket – 10” X 10” X 10”- New Wooden Basket Base. Students will learn how to weave using flat reed in natural/carnival colors, #4/#3 reed, sea grass, then embellish with glass beads. The Finished artwork will be a functional storage basket.

2) Claystone Clay 3-D Sculpture – Students will use at least 1 pound of air dry clay to create & sculpt a “Humanoid/Animal Cartoon Figure” using a variety of clay tools to detail. Once dry, (about a month), will paint and detail with acrylic paints.

3) Mono-print Ink Painting – Students will paint on Plexi a “Georgia O’Keefe” inspired painting by gaining ideas from visuals of the Artists key works provided by the teacher. Then learn how to use a “professional print machine” to transfer the image onto “Arches 88” – French Cotton Printing Paper.

Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive behaviors are required!
