



Spring 2017 Mini-Art Club

It is now time for students in 3rd and 4th grades to consider joining the “**Mini-Art Club**” for the Spring Semester. This is an after school club open to boys or girls who enjoy making challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art room #209, right after school until 5:00 p.m. All classes are conducted on normal open school days, (not Faculty Meeting Days) throughout the semester. The cost is \$200.00 per semester; February, March, April, May - a total of 10 classes. The first class is Wednesday, February 8th - last class is May 10th. All payments must be made out to Ronda Stieber, (not StJPII) and are due in full with the registration form to secure a spot. I will host an Ice Cream Party on the last club day!

All students are encouraged to bring water and a snack and report to the Art Room right after school.

Students will be walked down to carpool promptly at 5:00 p.m. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 will be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up their child from the Art room as needed.

The planned “Mini-Art Club Projects” are:

1) Acrylic/Gesso 2-Dimensional Abstract Painting - Multi-media will be used including fabric and yarn will be applied to the surface area of the 16” X 20” wooden framed canvas to create 2-D shapes/forms, then painted with Gesso to set/glue to the surface. Students will then freely paint with a colorful variety of acrylic paints in solids and metallic to detail their painting using different tools to create interesting design elements. This project takes longer to accomplish due to size and process, (5 classes).

2) Initial Wooden Plaque – Students will design/draw their Monogram or Initial large on a 12” X 9 1/2” Fluted Wooden Foundation. Next, students will glue a variety of glass beads to layer/embellish/create a design. Once this is finished, then we will paint with acrylic paints the remaining wood in a pattern.
