Testing Information

You will need to determine which test(s) your child should take when applying for high school based on the requirements unique to each one. Most students should only need to take one test as more and more schools will accept more than one. If your child has a choice between the HSPT or the ISEE, please consult your child's teacher or school counselor and we would be happy to explain the differences to help you decide if you are unsure.

ISEE: The ISEE is a three hour exam given to students entering high school. Pre-registration is required. Students must be registered by October 21, 2017 to avoid paying the late registration fee. Registration closes completely on October 28.

For students who qualify for accommodation support, please consult the ISEE website for instructions on how to sign up for them. Supporting documentation is required as well as a formal review which can take up to 3 weeks. <https://www.erblearn.org/parents/isee-overview>

HSPT : (High School Placement Test - administered through Scholastic Testing Service) The **HSPT®** is a comprehensive placement test for eighth graders for placement in the ninth grade. For over fifty years, high schools nationwide have used STS' **High School Placement Test (HSPT®)** to assist with admissions, scholarship selection, and curriculum placement. The deadline to register is Wednesday, Jan. 17, 2018.

For students who qualify for accommodation support, STS does not provide information nor grant any testing accommodations for students. Each high school has their own testing policy regarding accommodations and STS recommends that parents or guardians contact the school directly for information regarding the school's accommodations policy. The high school will let you know what, if any, accommodation is offered and if any type of documentation is needed. Please contact the high school where your child is taking the test to learn what they will need to receive accommodations for their test ahead of time.
