



“Art Club Fall Semester 2017”

It is now time for students in “**5th through 8th grade**” to consider joining the “**Art Club**” for the *Fall Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. Classes are held in the Art Room #209 every Monday right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes are conducted during normal “open” school days through the semester.

The cost is \$ 225.00 per semester for a total of 11 classes. The first class is Monday Sept. 11th – last class is Dec. 4th. On Dec 4th, I will host our semester end “*Pizza Party*” while student’s finish any remaining projects. All payments must be made out to **Ronda Stieber (not JPII)** and are due in full **with the completed registration form**, to secure a spot. All Students are *encouraged* to bring a Water and Snack. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class will begin promptly after set-up. Students will be walked down to car pool at 5:00 P.M. **Please pick up your child on time**. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 will be responsible for fees as per the Parent/Student Handbook. Note: Any Middle School Students who are trying out for sports teams may see me regarding as will try to work around schedules if possible once teams are posted.

The Planned Fall Art projects are:

1) Copper Metal Molded Wind-Chime/Mobile-embellished with glass beads/copper cut shapes/tubing. Students will learn 2-D metal molding to create a design in the copper then metal punch holes to lace their Chime together using gold/copper wire. We will lace colorful glass beads/pre-cut copper shapes/ along with copper tubing to complete.

2) Red Clay Coil Method 2-D Face- Students will draw with the teacher a cartoon male/female/animal image adding their own ideas 8” X 8” paper to create a template. Using the coil method, students will outline their drawing as learn how attach/score/clay to define facial features/hair/details. We will paint with acrylics once dry and mount on mat board.

3) Glass Mosaic Rectangle Shaped Candle Holder or Desk Organizer- Students will create a design using a variety of colored clear glass shapes using glass glue to secure. We will let each side dry until next class. Once finished we will grout with white cement to carefully fill in the spaces so when finished the light reflects through the glass shapes. Size 8” X 4”.
