



## “Art Club 2018 Spring Semester”

It is now time for students in **5th through 8th grade** to consider joining the “**Art Club**” for the *Spring Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art Room #209 on Monday’s right after school until 5:00 p.m.. All classes are conducted during normal “open” school days through the semester.

The cost is \$ 225.00 per semester: February, March, April-(includes May class), a total of 11 classes- the first class is Monday, February 5, and the last class is May 7<sup>th</sup>. I will host our “Pizza Party” on the last club day! All payments must be made out to **Ronda Stieber** (not StJPII) and are due in full with the registration form to secure a spot. All Students are *encouraged to bring Water and Snack* and should report to the Art Room after school. The classroom will be set up at 3:15 p.m. and class begins promptly at 3:30 p.m. after middle school dismissal.

Students will be walked down to car pool promptly at 5:00 p.m. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 p.m. will be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up your child from the art room as needed.

### **The Planned Spring projects are:**

**1) Navaho Frame Weaving** – Students will learn how to string their loom and learn various weaving techniques to create a variety of pattern, shapes, and forms. A broad variety of yarn tones and textures in natural tones , brights, and neons as students select and personalize their weaving in colors they like to create either a wall hanging or flat mat. Size approximately 12” X 18”. This project is longer term -will take two months to complete.

**2) Metal OJO-** Embellished on the ends with Semi-precious Stones and Beads. Students will create a Copper, Brass, Aluminum “OJO” as they learn three patterns to create a unique patterned 3 Dimensional art form in a 12” X 12” size.

...Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive behaviors are required!
