



Spring 2018 Mini-Art Club

It is now time for students in Elementary 3rd and 4th grades to consider joining the **“Mini-Art Club”** for the Spring Semester. This is an after school club open to boys or girls who enjoy making challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art room #209, right after school until 5:00 p.m. All classes are conducted on normal “open school days – not Faculty Meeting Days” through the semester. The cost is \$210.00 per semester; February, March, April, May - a total of 10 classes. The first class is Wednesday February 7th - last class is May 9th. I will host an “Ice Cream Party” on the last club day!

All payments must be made out to Ronda Stieber (not St. JP II) and are due in full with the registration form to secure a spot. All students are encouraged to “bring water and a snack” and report to the Art Room right after school. Students will be walked down to Car pool promptly at 5:00 p.m. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked-up by 5:15 will be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up their child from the art room as needed.

The planned “Mini-Art Club Projects” are:

1) Shell Picture Frame Project- Students will create a “Beach Themed Picture Frame” as they decorate a wooden framed mirror with a layers of sand first, then once dry decorate and fill the surface area with a variety of beautiful shells creating patterns, color, and texture. 11” X 14”

2) Tree of Life Collage- Students will learn to “Paint with Paper” as they create a layered landscape design using “handmade organic papers” that are torn into smaller shapes and collaged in a system onto the handmade foundation paper with natural wheat glue to create visual dimension. 11” X 14”.

3) Mono-print Ink Painting/Etching – Students will learn how to prepare/paint on Plastic-Plexi using a variety of ink colors then how to etch a design onto the dried ink. Students will be demonstrated the process of creating a “ Mono-print” with a “professional print machine” as they see how their painting is then transferred onto “Arches 88” – French Cotton print paper in 11” X 14”.
