Talent Show FAQs

Eligibility:

- ★ Acts may consist of solos, duets, or groups of up to 15 performers.
- ★ All performers must be enrolled in a Catholic school in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston
- ★ All performers must be in 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, or 8th grades.
- ★ Acts may consist of solos, duets, or groups of up to 15 performers.
- ★ Acts may only submit **ONE** video.
- ★ Acts must submit audition video and all signed paperwork by **12 AM, Friday, November 16th**. The video must be submitted exactly the way the Guidelines state below, or the video will not be accepted.
- ★ All acts that make the final talent show must attend the dress rehearsal on Sunday, January 27th, 1-4 pm and attend the actual show Saturday, February 2nd, 5:30- end of show.

Guidelines:

- ★ All acts must be 3 minutes or under, no exceptions.
- ★ Video audition should be a raw, unedited take of the act. Please do not use professional equipment to video. If background music is used for singers, make sure it does not drown out vocals.
- ★ The act submitted via video audition must be the act that will be used in the final contest. Performance, music, costume, props etc. must all be the same (minor changes to details are ok).

Guidelines (cont.):

- ★ Audition videos must be a link set as “Unlisted” on Youtube. The link should be sent in an email to mdunaway@stroselima.org with the subject line reading exactly “Audition- Catholic Schools Got Talent”.
- ★ Performers should introduce themselves in the video by saying the following: Their first name(s), school, grade(s), and what they will be performing.
- ★ Lyrics, costumes and performances should be compliant with school policy and appropriate for all audiences. Music, costumes, and performances will be screened for appropriateness.
- ★ Lip syncing, sing-a-long, or video game (Guitar Hero, Just Dance, etc...) acts will not be allowed. Dance routines should be rehearsed, no free-style dancing.
- ★ Any student auditioning with gymnastics, martial arts, or other training intensive routines must be well trained (coach or teacher approved tricks only).
- ★ All recorded music, instruments, simple props, costumes, etc for the act must be provided by the performer (s) (sound system and/or piano is provided)
- ★ If applicable, performers must supply their own music track. For vocal contestants, background music must be clear of any vocal singers on the track, only musical instruments are acceptable.

The finalists for the show will be announced December 7th via the Archdiocese Catholic Schools Got Talent webpage. (There will be a mandatory meeting for finalists and parents to attend. Details will be posted when the finalists are announced.)
