



“Art Club 2019 Spring Semester”

It is now time for students in “**5th through 8th grade**” to consider joining the “**Art Club**” for the *Spring Semester*. This is an after school club **open to boys or girls** who enjoy making a variety of challenging creative art projects. We meet in the Art Room #209 on Monday’s right after school until 5:00 P.M. All classes are conducted during normal “open” school days through the semester.

The cost is \$ 225.00 per semester: February, March, April, May a total of 11 classes- the first class is Monday Feb. 4th, and the last class is May 6th. I will host our “Pizza Party” on the last club day! All payments must be made out to **Ronda Stieber** (not JP II) and are due in full with the registration form to secure a spot.

All Students are *encouraged to bring Water and Snack* and should report to the Art Room after school. I will prepare set up of the classroom at 3:15 and class begins promptly at 3:30 after middle school dismissal.

Students will be walked down to car pool promptly at 5:00 P.M. Please pick up your child on time. Students who have not been picked up by 5:15 will be charged late fees according to the Parent/Student Handbook. If a student needs to leave earlier, parents may pick up your child from the art room as needed.

The Planned Spring projects are:

1) Hoop Weaving with Macramé – A wooden bamboo hoop will serve as the foundation as students create the warp to weave and macramé’ a layered design including Glass Beads to embellish – Finished project will be about 6” X 17”.

2) Canvas Covered Sketchbook- 8 1/2” X 11” book of 100 -Acid free pages. Students will decorate both sides and personalize using permanent Sharpie’s, in every color then include own designs and use a variety of templates to decorate on one side and may continue that process or choose to acrylic paint the other side.

3) Paper Mache’ 3-D Animal- Students will research a visual of an animal they want to create then construct the skeleton to make their species of animal come into being, as we layer paper Mache’ in a technique to create the features of their animal. We will paint the finished animal with acrylic paints and embellish with multi-media choices.

...Enrollment is limited - Intensified art techniques/tool usage are taught. Positive behaviors are required!
